International courses

Most Master's level courses are taught in English. For bachelor level and diploma degrees there are both English and Danish courses.

Tuition fee

There is no tuition for EU/EEA/CH citizens. Tuition fees for citizens of all other countries vary by programme/school and can be found on the school websites. Most master programmes have tuition fees in the range of 3300-8000 Euro per semester.

Living costs

Depends on lifestyle. Students' budget can be around 1100 Euro / mth ([Bank & Budget — Study in Denmark](#))

Work

In Denmark, most students - both Danish and international, work alongside their studies.

Beside the money, there are many good reasons to combine your studies with a student job or an internship (usually unpaid): Studies show that work experience can double your chances of landing a job after graduation.

Life after studies

After graduation, you can apply for jobs in Denmark. Students who complete higher education can generally stay in the country with a 6-month job-seeking permit.
